

## One Scotland Gazetteer

### Glossary

Please find below some common terms used within Gazetteer management.

**OSG** – One Scotland Gazetteer – Database of land and property data for Scotland.

**NLPG** – National Land and Property Gazetteer – Database of land and property data for England and Wales.

**SDTF** – Scottish Data Transfer Format – The format in which gazetteer data within Scotland is held.

**UPRN** – Unique Property Reference Number – A unique number to identify an individual property record.

**USRN** – Unique Street Reference Number – A unique number to identify an individual street record.

**BLPU** – Basic Land & Property Unit – Area of land, property or structure of fixed location.

**LPI** – Land & Property Identifier – A record that identifies a basic land and property unit.

**PAO and SAO** – Primary and Secondary Addressable Objects – levels of address information to differentiate between properties on the same street. For example:

Flat A 14 High Street	Flat 14 Gazetteer House New Street
Key – PAO and SAO	

**FULL** – This refers to a complete extract of the One Scotland Gazetteer.

**COU** – Change Only Update – An extract which details only the changes that have taken place within the One Scotland Gazetteer for a specific period of time.

**SNN** – Street Naming and Numbering – The process undertaken by a local authority to create addresses for the One Scotland Gazetteer.
